Camp concludes at 10 a.m. on Friday, July 2

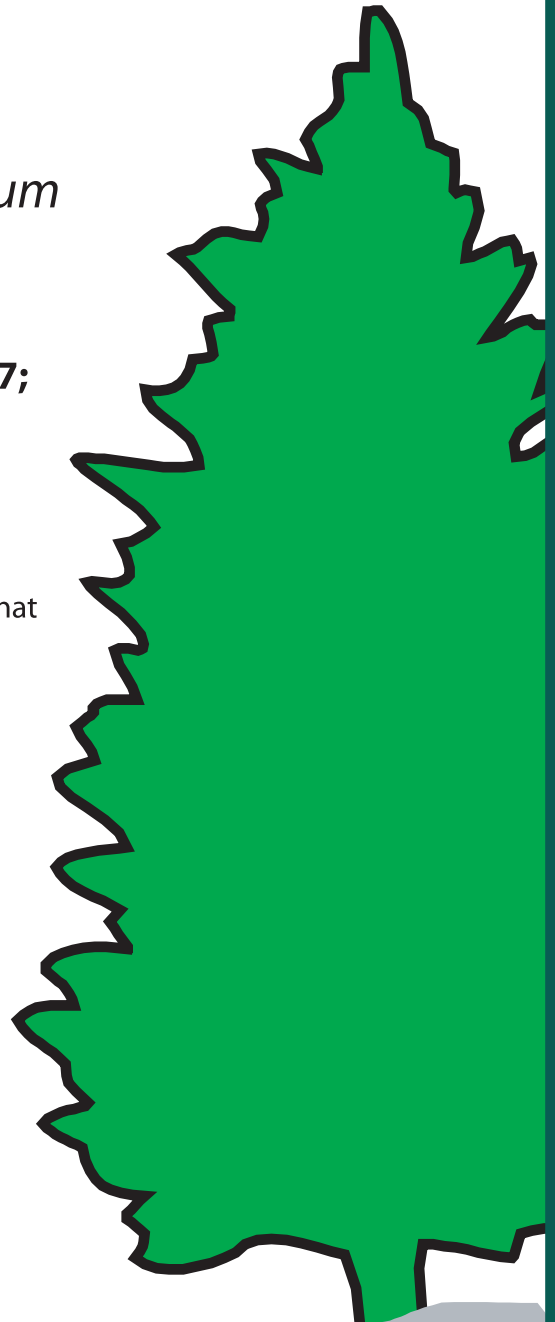

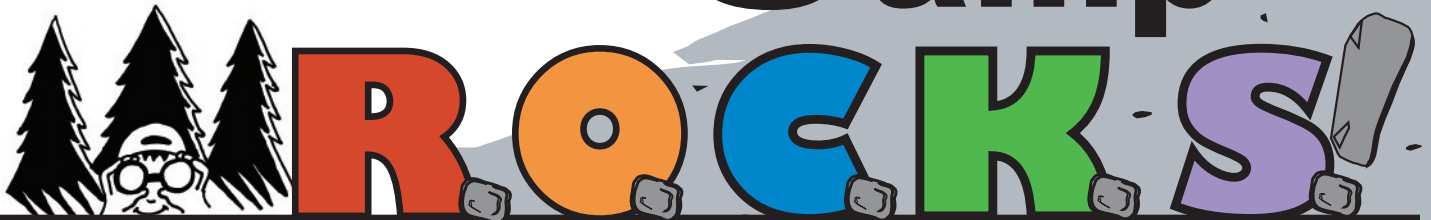

Camp R.O.C.K.S! will take place just northeast of Indianapolis in Noblesville, Indiana. All activities will be led by a team of professionals trained to work with individuals on the autism spectrum. Camp counselors will consist of parents, social workers, teachers, occupational therapists, speech pathologists and behaviorists in addition to peer mentors. Meals will be provided.
